# Summer Teams 2018

**Summer Teams is back! Starting Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> May! Whole month break in August!**

Last year Summer Team was a success and many people enjoyed the format.

This year will follow the same format. There will be a limited numbers of players, hopefully more reserve players available, the format of play will be '30 minute - as many points as you can get' (5-minute warm-up, 25 minutes play), and a few other tweaks. Hopefully this will encourage team spirit and ensure that the event is well supported.

The competition will start on Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> May, will continue each Tuesday throughout June and July (except the game for Tue July 17<sup>th</sup> which will be played on Wed July 18<sup>th</sup> due to cricket event). There will be quarter-finals, semi-finals and a finals night in September with a main and plate competition.

There will be six teams in each week and teams will consist of one of the following dependant on number of entries:

1. 2 squash player and 2 racketball players
2. 3 squash players and 2 racketball players

Handicaps will be used for all racketball games. Handicaps will be used for the third player squash positions if there is a third level. Handicaps will be assigned to all position 2 and reserve squash players in any event - but these will only be available when they stand-in for a number 1 position player (this will hopefully allow the number 1 players to get more opponents and help prevent number 1 players having to play many games on one night!)

**IMPORTANT:** If you put your name down to play then **YOU** are responsible for paying the £6 entry fee on the night. You can ask your stand-in player to pay the £6, but it is your responsibility to pay! **EVEN** if you pull out of the competition for **ANY** reason or you are not available on a specific night **YOU** must make sure the playing fee is paid. It is not fair to expect your team mates to pay extra to cover the lights and meal. This year we will be chasing payments and naming and shaming anyone that doesn't pay their fees!

If you feel you cannot commit then please consider putting your name down as a reserve so that you may possibly get one or two games.

Teams will be chosen on a "first-come, first-served" basis from the entry list. If there are more entries than available to make full teams, then players that don't make the teams will automatically be added to the reserve list

The price remains at £6 to include a meal and lights, and will run over opposite weeks. T-shirts will be team specific once again and be priced at £7.

We are hoping to have the weekly luck draw going again as well as prizes for the best player of the night and more. We have limited numbers to ensure everyone is committed and willing, please take a look through the rules and poster.
